Vocabulary

| Continents | The 7 large areas of land that stretch around the globe. |
| Oceans | The 5 major areas of water that lie between the continents. |
| Equator | The line that marks the centre of the earth. |
| North Pole | The cold region situated at the top of the globe. |
| South Pole | The cold region situated at the bottom of the globe. |
| Seasons | Each of the four divisions of the year (spring, summer, autumn, and winter) marked by particular weather patterns and daylight hours. |
| Desert | An area, often covered with sand or rocks, where there is very little rain and not many plants. |
| Iceberg | A large floating mass of ice broken from a glacier and carried out to sea. |
| Climate | The weather conditions in an area in general or over a long period. |
| City | A large town usually with a cathedral. |
| Village | A group of houses and buildings smaller than a town. |
