OUTBREAK PLAN

Hello Everyone,

This is the message I was dreading to send!

As you will all know by now, school have had to operate their outbreak plan. I will try to explain below how we will support them with this.

Timings:

Earlybird	session = 1 hour 5 mins
JB's	session = 2 hours 10 mins

Taking into account your child's start and finish times we ask that you keep to this in mind.

Set up

KS1/R will be based in the hall. They will have a table for each class where their activities will take place, unfortunately, we will not be able to offer the full range of equipment we would normally. Adele and Karen will be with the children permanently. If we have the chance to use the KS1 outdoor space, we will but the children will be all out or all in and separated into class bubbles due to staffing ratios.

KS2 will have a similar set up, with a table, for each class in the dining hall. Limited equipment will be rotated weekly. Myself, Vicky, Amanda and Cloe will be with these children. The KS2 outdoor area will be used where possible with the children in their class bubbles.

Snacks

Earlybirds will most probably be toast and fruit with water or milk to drink.

JB's will be in packets, where possible, to avoid children touching each other's food and to save on preparation and washing up. Staff will have to stay with their groups and finish times will be different. We will do our best to keep snacks to under 100 calories per serving and of course there will always be a selection of fruit as an alternative. Drinks will be water, milk and occasionally 50% fruit juice.

Drop off/collection

Parents will not be allowed in the building and must either wait at the blue gate for their children to be collected from them (Earlybirds) or wait at the blue gate (JB's) for their children to be brought to them.
